

Italian court cancels fine imposed on Moby, CIN

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Rome, Italy (PortSEurope) July 5, 2018 – The Italian Regional Administrative Court for Lazio has cancelled the fine of €29.2 million (\$34.2 million) that the Italian competition authority imposed on the shipping company Moby and the Italian Navigation Company (CIN) of the Onorato Armatori group for abuse of dominant position.

The suspension was welcomed with satisfaction by the Onorato Armatori group because it is a recognition of the validity of what was stated by the two companies, it said.

The competition watchdog imposed the fine on alleged abuse of dominant position of three lines of maritime transport of cargo between Sardinia and mainland Italy, in violation of Article 102 of the Treaty of the European Union.
