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The CEO Pompili, growing opportunities from the ship refitting market

(ANSA) – GENOA, 12 AUGUST – The De Wave group, leader in the naval outfitting sector for cruise ships and large yachts, in the first six months of the year completed and won new orders for over 104 million euros , thanks to a final rush in June. “De Wave continues to expand also thanks to a market that is diversifying the product confirming itself in excellent health – explains Riccardo Pompili, CEO of the group -. The new orders obtained and the positive balance of the works delivered, allow us today to confirm that 2022 it set sail with the wind in its sails. In addition to new shipbuilding, an increasingly consistent market share is represented by the refitting of ships that have been in operation for over 10 years “. In terms of new orders, which are added to the interventions already concluded in the first five months of the year, the first contract signed with Oceania Cruises provides for the refurbishment of over 600 cabins and various other areas of the “Marina” and “Riviera” units. , at Chantier Naval de Marseille.

The group has also acquired orders worth over 6 million euros each, for the public areas (restaurants, swimming pools, external decks) of the new Norwegian Cruise Line ships under construction in the Fincantieri di Marghera docks. Finally, the interior design of a Royal Caribbean unit under construction in the French Chantiers de l’Atlantique shipyard.
