

Green pass, Trieste harbor against obligation: “Let’s block the ports”

Federlogistica: “On ports, the State submits to blackmail” - The president of Federlogistica Luigi Merlo replies:” Tackling and treating the story of the port of Trieste as a problem of public order is a sensational mistake. Furthermore, the comparisons we had requested were promptly and constantly denied, with only one result: the State is now submitting to an unacceptable blackmail. ”For Merlo, he is politically confirmed as a de facto” commissioner “of the Ministry of Infrastructure.

Genoa, some companies will pay the tampons to employees – In Genoa, some terminal operators at the port will pay tampons to employees without a Green pass, the president of the Confindustria sector association Beppe Costa said after a meeting in the prefecture. “The decision is made by each company – he explains -, some have given their availability and others are free to choose. Like Confindustria, we reiterate that the rules say that the worker pays the buffer”. Among the Genoese dockers 20 out of 100 are not vaccinated.

High percentage of vaccinated in Venice – The situation promises to be calm at the port of Venice where, according to the lagoon port Authority, the high percentage of vaccinated people should allow a day without problems.

Naples and Salerno, on with port activity – In the ports of Naples and Salerno, however, problems relating to the entry into force of the Green pass are not expected. According to union sources, the number of no-vax workers in those structures is minimal and does not compromise the regular activities of the two airports. In recent days, reports Filt-Cgil Campania, no hint of protest has emerged regarding the debut of the “green card” in the workplace.

No problem in Puglia – There will be no problems even in the five ports of Manfredonia, Barletta, Bari, Monopoli and Brindisi, where the secretary general of the Southern Adriatic Port System Authority, Tito Vespasiani, assures: “We are not afraid of particular critical situations, strikes or blocks. In our five ports the vaccination rate reaches 100% in some sectors “.
