

CEPAS with the yacht specialists team of Bureau Veritas launches the certification of skills for the refitting of large yachts

Lavagna, 20 September 2018 – An ad hoc team to assist the big yachts, a certification system that goes back to the reliability of the shipyard and its infrastructures, a new certification product designed for boat refitting pleasure craft.

It is with these “tools” that CEPAS (Institute of certification of the professionalism and skills of the Bureau Veritas group), in close collaboration with super yacht specialists of Bureau Veritas, has entered strongly and with a completely new certification formula in the market of large yachts; the first step was achieved through the certification of the CARM shipyard in Lavagna, where an innovative certification was developed based on the best practices guaranteed (and verified through CEPAS) of the main professional subjects who interact on the construction site starting from the master of ax until you get to those responsible for the design or fittings. A bottom-up certification that from the verification and certification of the skills of the individual dates back to that of the construction site.

The delivery of the first SEA certificate, which stands for Shipyard Excellence Assessment, will be officially delivered to the Lavagna shipyard on September 26th at the Montecarlo Boat Show and will mark a turning point in both the certification of skills and the overall work systems in such a specialized and delicate field, like that of large pleasure boats.
