

Genoa port's Terminal Messina to handle MSC container vessel for first time

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Genoa, Italy (PortSEurope) September 6, 2017 – Genoa's Terminal Messina, operated by Ignazio Messina & C., will handle a container ship of Mediterranean Shipping Company (MSC) for the first time on September 8.

The ship will be Songa Alya, a container vessel with 3,100 TEUs that is used by MSC for the operation of the MAF1 service through a vessel sharing agreement with Ignazio Messina and COSCO.

The MAF1 service was launched on August 28 with the departure of Calais Trader vessel operated by COSCO. The service links the western Mediterranean region to West Africa.
